Hunting season is just around the corner and it's time to renew your membership!

IMPORTANT: You must be a current member in order to RENEW your membership for the 2009-10 year. If you are not a current member, you will be required to pay an initiation fee (\$100) and your yearly dues (\$100, Total cost \$200) to rejoin the club. How do you know if you are a current member? Look at your membership card. If it says it expires August/September 2009, you are a current member and can renew your membership (\$100) without paying an initiation fee.
